Our Programs

LUNCH PALS & LUNCH PALS+

Our school-based mentoring program, Lunch Pals, connects mentors with children identified by the school who may struggle with social skills, lack of confidence, behavioral challenges, attention-seeking behaviors, or disinterest in school. Every other week, mentors offer a supportive, listening ear during lunch, helping these children build self-esteem and improve social interactions. Lunch Pals+ extends this support to children with disabilities, providing tailored mentorship to meet their unique needs.



PEN PALS

Pen Pals pairs students with mentors for an enriching school-year experience, exchanging hand-written letters throughout the year. This program provides crucial support to children as they develop academic skills, self-confidence, and a positive self-concept. Through consistent communication and encouragement, students gain motivation, feel valued and build stronger

connections with their mentors. The result is impressive, with a 63% improvement in reading skills and a 69% boost in writing..

WORLD OF WORK

In the World of Work program, mentors are paired with high school students to explore potential careers and gain valuable insights through the mentor's real-world career experiences. Students participate in mock interviews, receive constructive feedback, have their resumes reviewed, and learn the essentials of personal branding. The program also provides internship opportunities to seniors, offering hands-on experience to help them transition smoothly into the workforce. This comprehensive approach equips students with the tools and confidence they need to succeed in their future careers.
